SCENE ONE

Teacher leaves, and the students turn to one another.

Leah: What are you talking about? This is all your fault. I shouldn't even be here.

Brad: Well you spread the stupid photo of Rachel around for everyone to see.

Eddie: *(chiming in with Brad)* Yeah, you spread it.

Leah:*(addressing Damian)* Well so did you! You just wanted attention.

Damian: And you didn't? Didn't we all want something out of that picture?

Everyone looks taken aback and looks over at the Damian, he's kind of just staring off into space. Leah opens her mouth to snap back but before she can, Janitor walks in and immediately starts ordering the kids around.

Janitor: Alright kids, this is how it's gonna happen tonight. The two of you *(points to Brad and Damian)* are going to cover the main hallway and Level 100. The other two *(gestures to Leah and Eddie)* are gonna take care of Level 300 and outside. I'll be on the main floor, so you two come find me when you're ready to do outside.

Janitor gestures to Brad and Damian first, then to Leah and Eddie. Kids groan and huff at their assigned partners.

Janitor: You're gonna do as I say or you'll be cleaning the bathrooms as well!

Brad: Whatever. Let's just get this over with. C'mon Creep, let's go do downstairs.

SCENE TWO

Damian and Brad are walking down a slightly darkened hallway on the first floor. They are both not doing much work.

Brad: Hey, you really shouldn't have called out Leah you know?

Damian looks to be ignoring him and walks ahead of Brad a bit, noticeably quickening his pace.

Brad: Even if she is wrong. I know why you really sent around that picture.

Damian stops dead in his tracks.

Damian: I don't know what your talking about.

Brad: I'm talking about how Rachel rejected you just a few days before you spread that picture of her. Now I understand that Eddie just wanted attention and to fit in, but you... you wanted revenge.

Damian turns around.

Damian: It's not like that!

Brad gets up in Damian's face.

Brad: Sure seems that way to me.

Damian contemplates violence for a second, then sighs and looks away.

Damian: We better keep moving, this hallway is clean and I wanna get out of here.

Damian turns abruptly and starts walking away.

SCENE THREE

Leah and Eddie wandering through the halls (upstairs), walk into a classroom and begin collecting the recycling. There has been a drawn out awkward silence and Eddie aware that something needs to be said, but Leah is content with the silence.

Eddie: So, Leah, this is a pretty crappy situation, huh?

Leah doesn't so much as glance away from her task.

Leah: Who are you again?

Eddie: Really? I'm Eddie, I'm in your English class with Ms Adams. Ring any bells?

Leah: Uh, honestly, not really. I'm a very busy person, and I don't usually have time to pay attention to wannabe nobodies.

Leah still doesn't look up, but waves a dismissive hand in his direction. Eddie looks very hurt, and you can see his insecurities at the surface

Eddie: Don't you remember? We've gone to school together since the second grade.

Leah: *(shrugs nonchalantly)* I guess not.

Eddie: Oh, okay I get it. I was just trying to make conversation. Just trying to pass the time.

Leah straightens up and turns towards Eddie

Leah: Okay, well that's all great, but could you, you know, do all that in your head.

Gestures randomly with her hands towards Eddie.

Leah: I just want to finish this dumb job so I can go home and never speak of any of this again.

Eddie: Whatever you want.

Eddie nervously nods and gestures a lock on his mouth and “throws away the key”.

Eddie picks up the bag of garbage, and quickly flees the classroom, with Leah behind him, looking indifferent.

SCENE FOUR

Leah and Eddie wandering through the hallways, make note of the fact that the halls are empty and that they are alone. Make their way to the Janitors closet and reach to open the door. Suspenseful music plays as they grab the handle. Janitor suddenly appears from behind the kids. (False jump scare)

Janitor: *(loudly and obnoxiously)* There you are! You should’ve been here a while ago.

Leah: *(sarcastically)* Oh I’m sorry, we’ve only been doing *your* job for the past hour.

Janitor: Well with your track records you better get used to it. I left the garbage bags in the drama room, so go grab them and meet me outside at the bins.

Janitor walks away and Leah sighs as her and Eddie wander away.

SCENE FIVE

Leah and Eddie walk into drama room and split up. Focus on Leah searching for bags in prop room. Pan around room to see varied props

and see Leah flinch at the creepiness of it all. Make sure camera sees the 3 masks in the prop room. She searches and the Eddie creeps up behind her in a mask and scares Leah.

Leah: Ah! Jesus, Eddie! don't scare me like that. You're so immature.

Eddie: *(laughing)* Haha I got you so good, didn't I?

Places the mask back with the others and slowly looks around the closet.

Eddie: Hey, it's, uh, pretty creepy in here. L-let's just grab those bags and head outside.

Leah: What, are you scared or something? *(Snickers, hiding the fact that moments before she was the scared one)*

Eddie: Hey, just shut up and let's go.

Eddie stomps off and Leah grabs garbage bags and runs after him.

The two make their way to the doors leading outside, where they are to meet the Janitor. As they attempt to open the doors, they are unsuccessful and quickly realize they are locked in somehow. You can see the panic growing on their faces.

Leah: What the hell? What is this? *(Turns to Eddie accusingly)* Eddie, was this you? Another one of your stupid pranks?

Eddie: What? No way. This isn't me.

Leah: Well someone locked us in. You know, I bet it was that asshole janitor, I knew he was a creep. *(Begins banging on the door, trying to get the janitor's attention)* Ugh, What now?

Eddie: Um, maybe we should just try another door? Then we can find the others.

Leah: *(obviously nervous)* Alright, come on.

Drags Eddie to find the others.

SCENE SIX

Camera follows Eddie and Leah running frantically down the hallway trying to find the other two. They cut around a corner and run into the other boys (jump scare).

Brad: What the hell!? Do you two morons ever look where you are going?

Ignoring Brad's question, she asks frantically.

Leah: Have you tried leaving the school?!

Damian: Why would we do that? We'd just end up being in more shit.

Eddie: No, like, we are stuck here. Inside the school.

Brad: What do you mean stuck here? Haven't you tried the front door?

Groups walks to the front of the school and Leah makes an example of trying the door. "Clank"

Brad: What the hell? That's weird. Have you asked the Janitor to open it?

Eddie: He already left. We're stuck here.

Suddenly, all of the group's phones vibrate simultaneously. They all stare at each other and reach into their respective pockets, looking freaked out. They all check their phones,

Leah's text reads:

Eddie's text reads:

**We know who you are
We know what you've done

Damian's text reads:

**We know who you are
We know what you've done
You've ruined a life
We're ruining yours
Flying alone makes you believe you are different than them
But you reap the same sins as the flock
(bird emoji)**

Brad's text reads:

We know who you are

We know what you've done
You've ruined numerous lives
We're ruining yours
The animals you've raised have grown too great
The time has come for the slaughter
(farmer emoji)

Leah gasps.

Eddie: Wh-what is this?

Brad: So I take it you guys got a message too?

Damian: Yeah, but it's probably just Rachel trying to get back at us, explains the locked doors. She's getting her spooky revenge...

Damian treating the whole thing as a prank being pulled.

Eddie: Damian, don't be stupid. That would never happen.

Brad: *(to Eddie)* Actually, he has a point.

Eddie nervously and awkwardly tries to play off his wrongful opinion.

Eddie: You know I was just playing with you, Damian. *(Trying to fit in)*

Leah: Well there is no way she could have possibly locked up the whole school. Lets split up and try some other exits.

Brad: How about we meet back here in 10 minutes then?

Damian: Ok, ten minutes.

All split up in search of an open door.

SCENE SEVEN

We see the students, one by one trying to open doors/checking for exits. As they are travelling through the school, they're seeing flashes of the figures in mirrors and windows. The audience can see the figures sometimes behind them, and although the students are unaware, they seem to be more and more on edge.

See Leah trying to open a side door, shaking the door violently.

Leah: Ugh, come on!

Turns around to try a different door, but catches a glimpse of a shadow from around the corner. She grows scared and runs the opposite way.

See Damian sprinting to the Cafeteria doors, tries the first door (is locked), then moves quickly to the second. When he realizes that it too is locked, he slams fist against the door.

Damian: God dammit, you've got to be kidding.

Leans forehead against the door, and sighs. Then lifts head to look out the window. Sees reflection and sees a figure behind him.

Damian: What the hell?

Immediately turns around and sees figure has vanished. Damian doesn't move, as he is paranoid. He slowly, (on the lookout for figure) makes his way to a different door.

Brad walks to a door and tries opening. Rattles the handle roughly, then moves on. He passes a dark classroom, and out of the corner of his eye, spots a shadow or figure. Sees a glimpse of an animal mask. Goes to the window, and looks through. Scans the room, and standing in the corner is the figure, camera does a double take and masked thing is

gone. Brad jumps back from the window and quickly stumbles off, looking back nervously as he moves away.

Now see Eddie, visibly skittish, cautiously making his way towards a door (idk which one). Not even reaching the door yet, he sees movement at the end of a hallway. He immediately starts to hyperventilate and visibly more scared. He goes to hide behind a locker and slowly moves to look back down the hallway. He sees a glimpse of the figure in a mask, closer than it was before.

Eddie: *(shaky voice)* Brad? Is that you? Leah? Come on guys, this isn't funny.

Figure stares directly in Eddie's direction, and this sets him off the edge, and he runs back to the group's meeting spot

SCENE EIGHT

Brad, Eddie, and Damian are back in the location they had previously been in. They're all afraid from seeing the figures, but none of them have brought it up. They've all assumed they're just imagining things. Eddie is the most scared. Brad is hiding his fear with anger.

Eddie: Why don't we just break a window or something?

Damian: Yeah, let's get ourselves in even more trouble.

Brad: Oh, shut up. Both of you. I'll just call my mom, she'll get someone to come get us out of here.

Brad pulls out his phone, and tries to turn it on, but it's dead.

Brad: What the hell? It's dead.

Damian: So? You probably forgot to charge it.

Brad: No, it was at like, 80% an hour ago.

Damian: So we'll use mine.

Damian pulls out his phone. It is also dead.

Damian: Huh?

Eddie also has his phone out. He's panicking.

Eddie: Mine's dead too, guys.

Damian: Maybe we could try some of the sch-

Leah appears suddenly. (Maybe false jump scare?)

Leah: Hey, Eddie! What in the world is wrong with you?

The boys all looked shocked and confused.

Eddie: What do you mean?

Leah: You're running around the school trying to scare me! I know it was you. You did the same thing earlier, with those masks!

Eddie is a little bit embarrassed.

Brad: Wait, it was you messing around with those masks?

Eddie: No! I did it earlier to Leah, but I haven't since. Did you guys both see those weird figures too?

Damian: I saw one. With an animal head.

Leah: Now you're all trying to scare me? This isn't funny. You guys are sick. While you guys learn to be more mature, I'm going to the ladies room.

Leah marches off.

Brad: So those mask things, they really were real?

Eddie and Damian nod, and all three boys look terrified.

SCENE NINE

Leah wanders into the girls washroom and looks at herself in the mirror, adjusting her appearance, distracting herself. She gasps as she is suddenly captivated by a masked figure in the mirrors reflection behind her and immediately turns around, but the figure vanishes. She is convinced she is seeing things. She splashes water on her face, and as soon as she rises to the mirror, the figure is behind her and you hear a blood-curdling scream as the camera shifts and you hear the sound of her head being smashed into the sink. There is blood splattered on the walls, mirrors and sink. There is no direct view of the damage, but from the splatter on the killer, you know she dies. See the masked figure leave her on the ground, and camera shifts to hover over her body, watching the killer leave her in the bathroom.

SCENE TEN

Brad, Damian and Eddie have been waiting for Leah for awhile, and are getting anxious to leave.

Eddie: What do you think those things *are*?

Brad: Chill! It's your imagination. We've been here for hours. You're probably just tired.

Eddie: Okay. I just wish we could get out of here.

Damien: You know, maybe it's Rachel getting her revenge.

Brad (*Sarcastically*): Yeah, cause Rachel's a six foot tall dude in a mask.

Damien: She could have hired hitmen. It's not that hard, you know.

Eddie: Wait, actually?!

Brad: Don't listen to him. I'm gonna go get Leah so we can figure out a way out of here. You guys wait here.

Brad starts walking away. Eddie gets spooked by his own reflection in a window, and runs after Brad.

SCENE ELEVEN

Eddie is trailing behind Brad as they head down the hall. Brad is pretty much speed walking down the hall.

Eddie: Can you maybe slow down?

Brad: Do you want to get out of here, or not?

Eddie sees a figure suddenly, and begins panicking more, catching up to Brad.

Eddie and Brad walk into the girls washroom, obviously both very on edge. As they peer around the corner, they get a glimpse of the grotesque scene of Leah's dead body. They flip out, and try to get out of the room as fast as they can. Eddie starts to scream and Brad looks over to see that he tripped over something (maybe a bench or something, idk). Eddie and Brad stumble out of the washroom together because the Eddie is injured Brad is holding him up with their arms around each other. They look around for a hiding spot. The lights flicker slightly for a second.

Eddie: Under the bleachers!

Without questioning it, Brad leads the Eddie under the bleachers. Eddie sits down against the wall with his leg up on something. Both Brad and Eddie are breathing heavily. They start to catch their breath.

Brad: I need to find Damian, he's out there by himself. He shouldn't be alone.

Eddie: You can't just leave me here, I'm hurt.

Brad: I have to. We can't let him die. He doesn't know what's out there. You'll be safe here. Just don't move!

Eddie: Fine, just hurry, please!

Brad gets up and leaves running round the front of the bleachers out of view. Eddie watches him leave, the fear showing on his face.

SCENE TWELVE

Damian is leaning up against the wall, staying alert for the others. He doesn't see anything and starts to feel safer. Just when he begins to physically relax, he sees a flash of a figure in a window. He becomes extremely on edge at that point. It is gone, and he turns his head to see the same figure in the opposite side of him than it was previously. It is quickly gone. Damian is now very aware of his isolation from the others.

Damian: Brad!? Leah?! Eddie!?

When he receives no response, he tries again.

Damian: Where are you guys?!

*Damian peers down both halls. He sees another flash of a figure.
Damian runs in the opposite direction.*

SCENE THIRTEEN

Eddie is still sitting with his back against the wall, wincing occasionally. He's looking down at his hurt leg but is jolted up at a sharp metallic sound. After a short pause he notices the bleachers starting to close in slowly. Eddie begins to panic.

Eddie: Hey, Brad! Stop it, this isn't funny! Leah is dead, and you're seriously joking around?!

The bleachers continue to close in. We see one of the masked killers pushing them. Eddie starts trying to crawl away and even manages to get to his feet but is too slow. The bleachers close all the way with a crash and a small squishing sound. Blood pours out from beneath the closed bleachers.

SCENE FOURTEEN

Brad walks back into the gym. He is alone, and afraid. He is shouting out before he turns the corner. There is no view of the bleachers, and he can't see that they're closed yet.

Brad: Eddie?! Come out, I couldn't find Damien. Can you walk?

Brad turns the corner when he doesn't hear a response.

Brad: Eddie?

Brad notices the closed bleachers, and thinks that Eddie must have left.

Brad: EDDIE?!

Brad looks down at the floor by the bleachers, and sees the blood that has trickled out on the floor. At first he is confused, but he puts two and two together and realizes what happened. Fearful that he will be next, Brad bolts from the room searching for the only other remaining student.

SCENE FIFTEEN

Brad runs into the library looking for Damian, he is clearly worried sweating a little. He is frantically looking around when he sees Damian come out from behind a bookshelf. Damian has clearly been hiding.

Damian: What's going on? You look like shit.

Brad: Leah and Eddie are fucking dead.

Damian: Stop screwing around.

Brad: I'm serious. They're dead. Leah had her head...

Brad starts trailing off and is almost in tears.

Brad: Her head... It was horrible. And Eddie was crushed behind the bleachers.

Damian: Jesus Christ. We need to find somewhere to hide.

Brad: The boiler room! We should go there.

Damian: Okay... okay you're right. Let's go.

They exit the library quickly heading for the stairs.

SCENE SIXTEEN

Damian and Brad enter the boiler room Damian is holding up his lighter to show the way in the dark. The faint light illuminates boilers panels and various things in the room. He passes the lighter past a few objects when all of a sudden one of the masked killers is lit up in the gloom. Damian is nervous deep down but is playing it off well for now. Brad is scared.

Brad: Run!

Damian: No this is all bullshit. They aren't monsters there is 2 of us and one of him.

Brad: I'm not fighting that thing! They already killed two people tonight.

Brad runs away out of the boiler room but Damian stays.

Damian: Please? Really expect me to believe that cheap get up?

Damian chuckles nervously. He puts his hands up. The killer tilts their head to the side like an animal.

Damian: Screw you then!

Damian lunges at the masked killer. The killer easily dodges by moving only slightly out of the way. As Damian over swings he is tripped up by the killer who kicks his legs out from under him. BRAD: Just get it over with! Do it, kill me! You've ruined me, I deserve it anyways.

**Closes his eyes preparing for his death, he waits, expecting his death but nothing happens, he opens his eyes hoping they are gone but to only see them 4 inches away from his face. Screams for mercy as they brutally snap one of his legs, (thus ruining his future athletic career) and they disappear all of a sudden.*

BRAD: FUUUUUUUUCKKKKKKKKKKKKKKKKK!

SCENE EIGHTEEN

Sobbing on the floor Brad finally decides to try the door one last time, it opens and he crawls slowly to the grass and collapses, (is he dead or is he alive). Zooms in and his phone turns on and gets a multiple notification.

PHONE

(Friends and fellow students):

**why would you do that?*

**you ruined Rachel's life*

**another douchey move, classic brad*

**(team snap):*

Reminder all star tryouts on Sunday.

(Mom):

**On your way home?*

**where are you?*

**call me ASAP!*

**4 missed phone calls*
