Congratulations on your new student Aaron Porter 1.3, commonly referred to as “Aaron”. Your new student comes with some exciting new features:

GETTING STARTED

To get the best results out of Aaron, you are going to want to turn on your Sound Field system and be facing him before accessing it. Aaron will understand people who do this more accurately and give better results.

ACCESSIBILITY

Accessing Aaron is not difficult at all! He spends a majority of his time on technology, usually his iPad for watching YouTube or his computer for playing video games or using Blender.

Aaron likes to post his 3D work to Instagram and is very active on there. He often operates under the name “Creatively Bad” for his 3D work online and if you are curious about his work you can search him up there @creatively_bad.

SETTINGS/MODES

Aaron’s three most common settings are Student, Content Viewer, and Regular Human.

Setting 1: Student

Aaron can often be found in the student setting. When in this setting he will often get super focused and really into his work. When in this mode it can be difficult to get his attention and sometimes he will keep working while stuff is going on in class. In this mode, Aaron usually will get frustrated if the class is moving slowly. He will often want to move quickly in student mode and try to finish as much work as possible.

Setting 2: Content Viewer

The content viewer setting is basically Aaron's default setting. This mode will often occur when he is feeling tired or just plain lazy. When in this mode he will usually be watching Netflix and YouTube and will often ignore everything going on around him. When in this mode it can be extremely difficult to get his attention and he will usually not hear you.

Setting 3: Regular Person

In the regular person setting he can often be found sitting at his computer. In this setting, he has 2 main actions. His first one is usually him sitting at his computer working on new renders in Blender or making videos for YouTube. This usually takes place on weekends or days with no school. His second one is him sitting at his computer playing video games. Mostly this consists of playing Minecraft but sometimes he likes to play Halo as well. He will also sometimes play with friends online. This one also will mostly take place on weekends and he can spend hours in this state.

WARNINGS

TROUBLESHOOTING

Problem	Solution
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You are unhappy with the work (quality, missed some instructions, etc.).	Pull Aaron aside and show him what was incorrect as well as explain all the instructions to make sure he has not missed anything else.
Didn't receive an assignment that was due.	Let Aaron know that you have not received the assignment and he will make sure that it is all handed in.
The hearing tech is not working.	If the hearing tech stops working or there is a problem with it (Sound field, mic, etc.). Let Aaron know and he should be able to fix it or at least get a hold of someone who can.

TIPS TO MAINTAIN OPTIMAL PERFORMANCE

To get the best results out of Aaron make sure to:

- Speak clearly and loudly
- Wear the sound field system microphone
- Face Aaron/Classroom

NEW SOFTWARE
