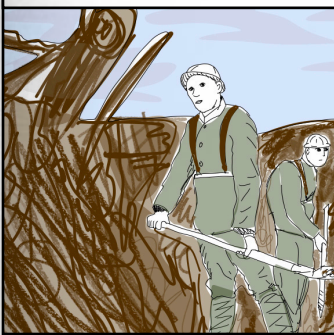
BY MAY 19TH THE 7TH AND 2ND DIVISION WERE ABLE TO RETREAT...



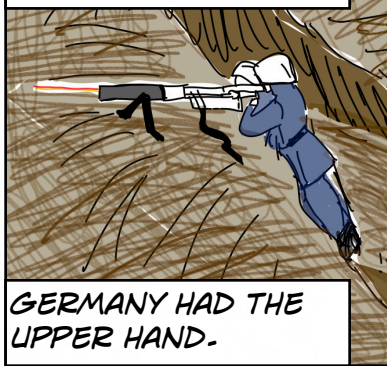
ALSO, ON MAY 18TH THE 1ST CANADIAN DIVISION CAME TO HELP THE 51ST BRITISH DIVISION...

BUT, THE GERMANS BROUGHT REINFORCEMENTS...

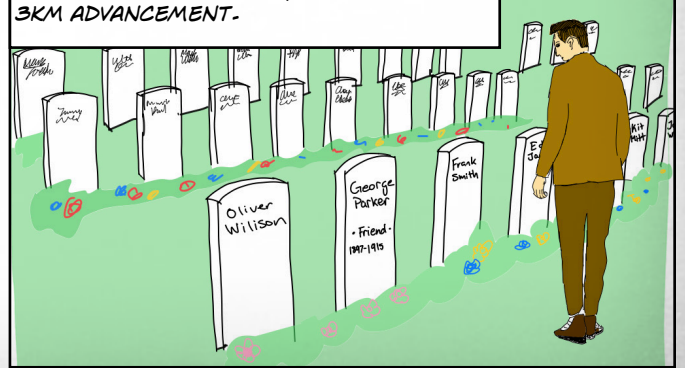
