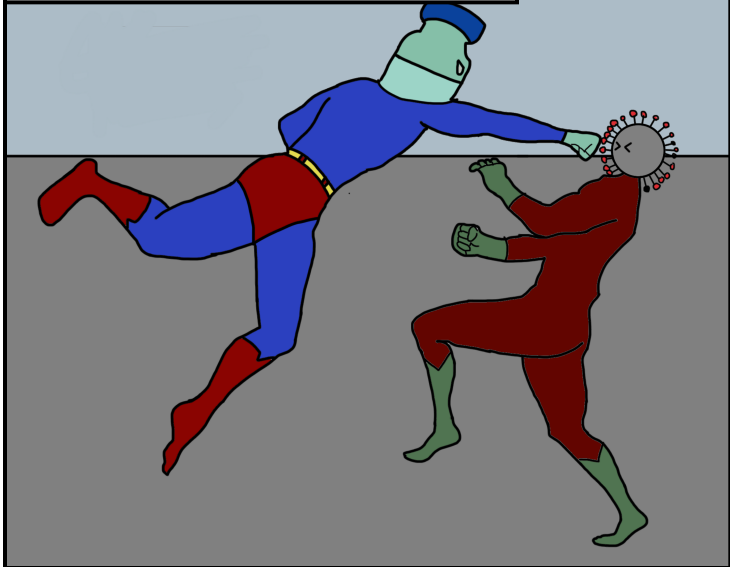
Superheroes! I call it "Supercells."



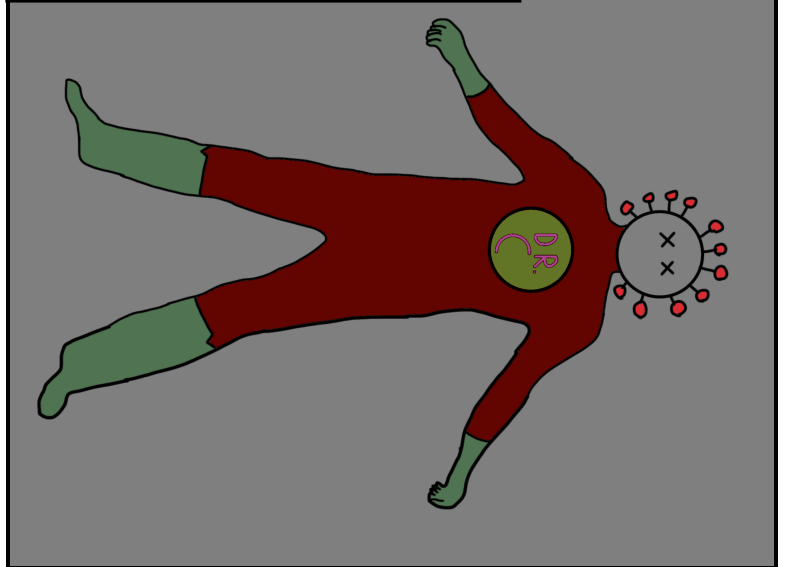
Here's the basic idea of the comic. So there's this superhero named Vaccine Man. He fights crime, saves the city, you know classic superhero stuff.

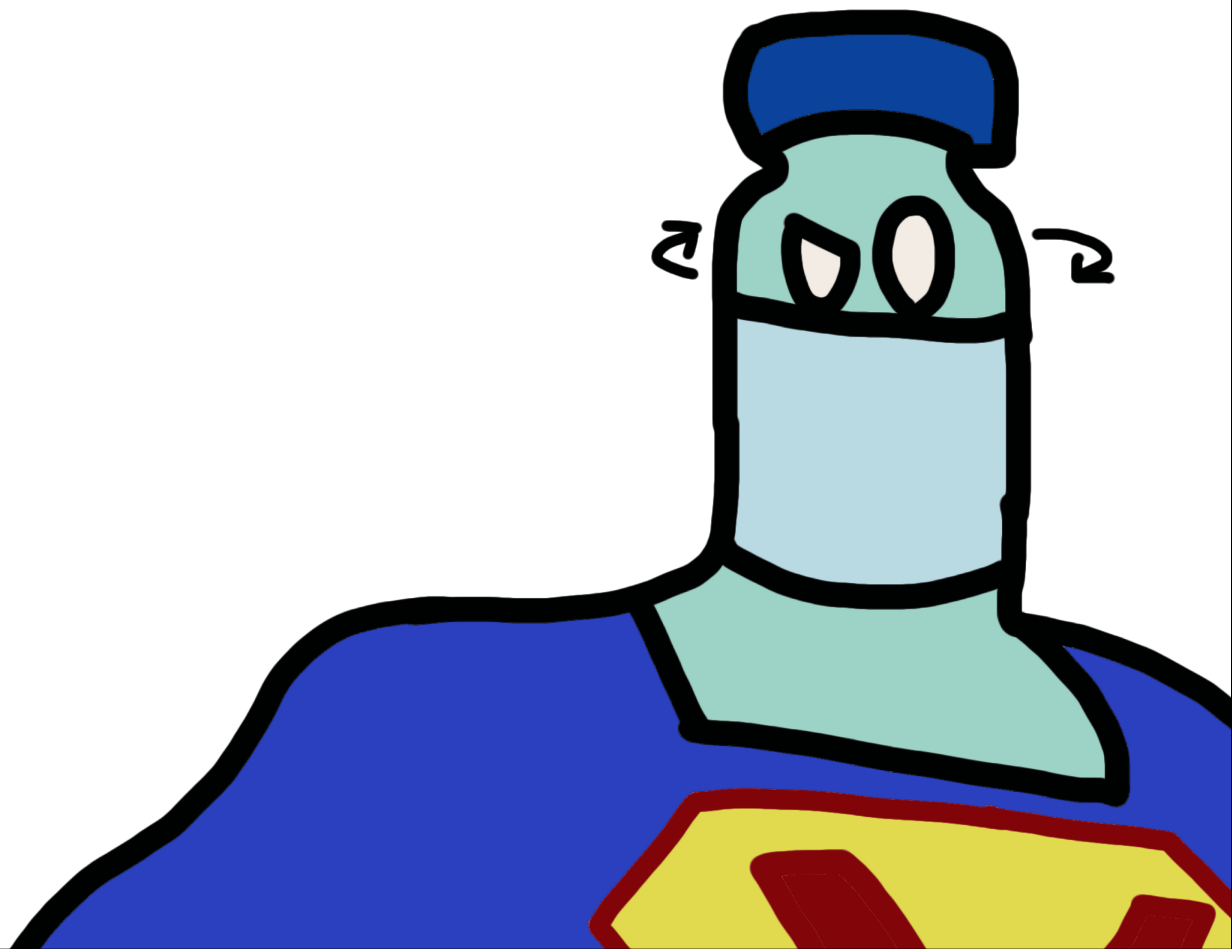


Well, one day Vaccine Man is fighting his nemesis Dr. Corona.
