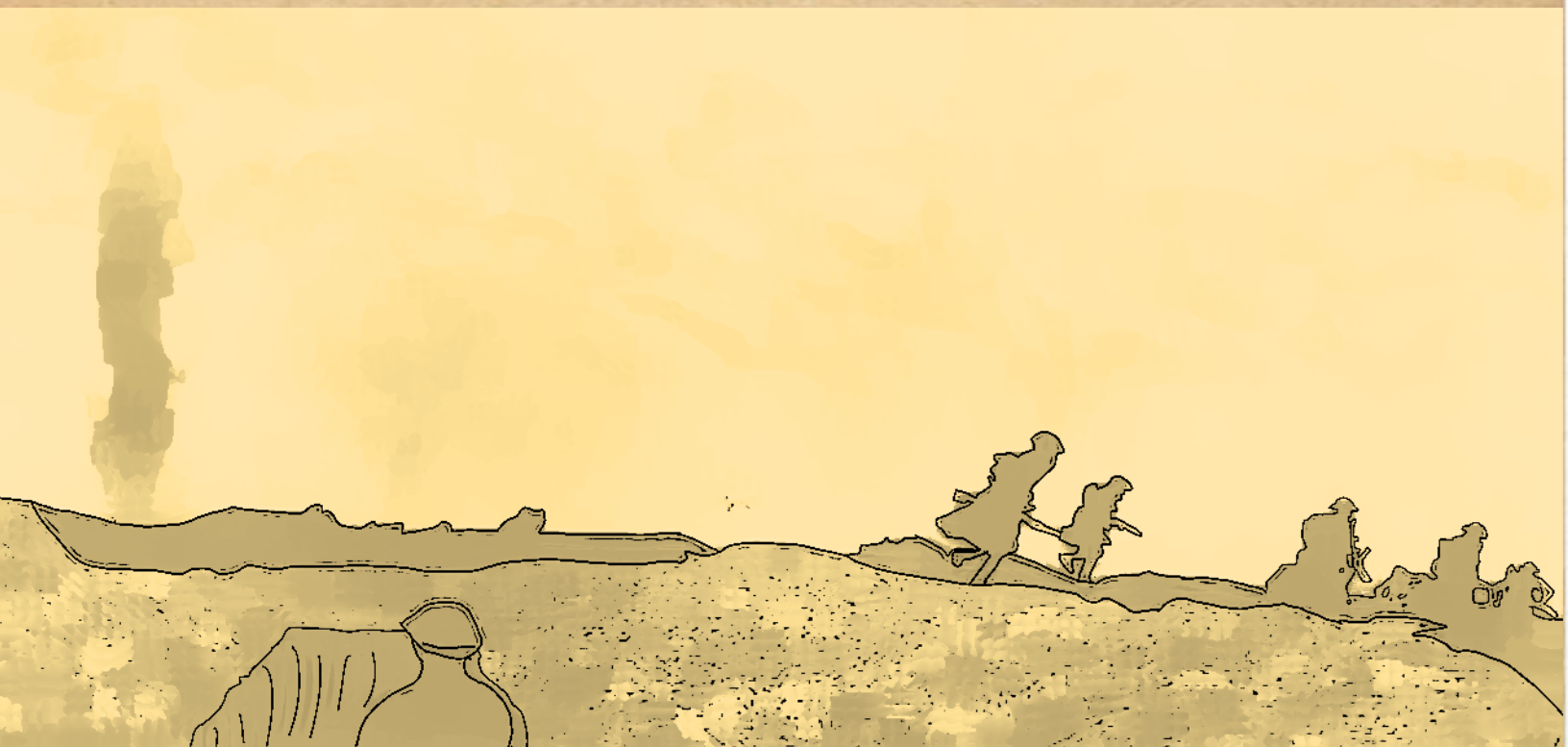

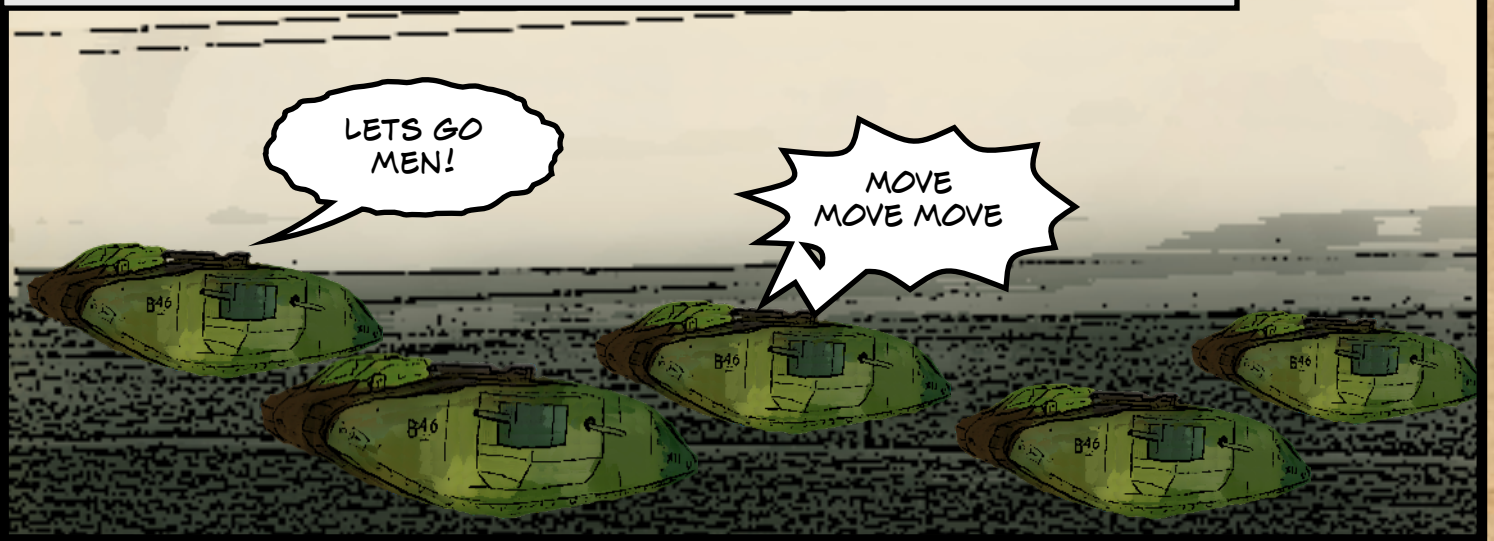
THE BLOODY

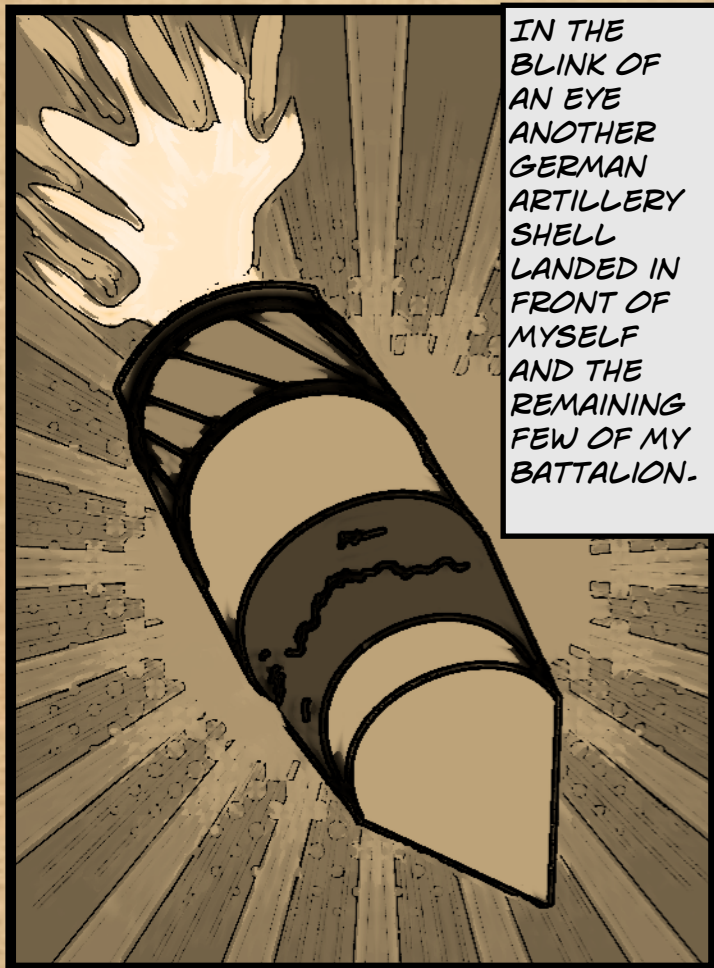

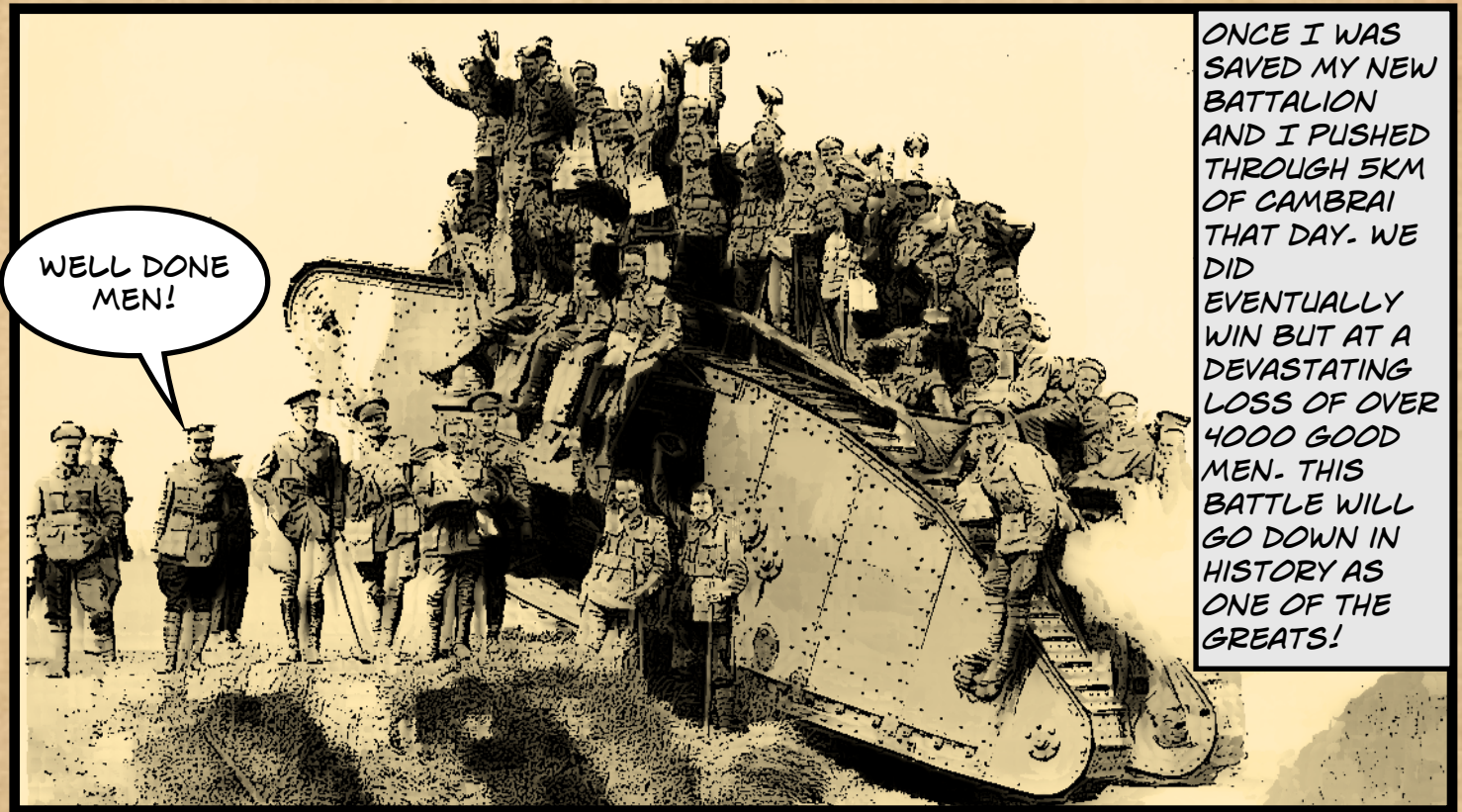
